FY 2019 – FY 2028 CIP

Requested: \$29.330 million will support:

- Fulfillment of Park Master Plans -- Jennie Dean, Rosslyn Highlands
- Provision of Maintenance Capital – Playgrounds, fields, courts, picnic facilities, etc.
- Support Synthetic Turf Maintenance/Conversion
- Trail Modernization
