## Minutes - January 4, 2000

- 1. The president called the meeting to order at 7:35 PM.
- 2. Approval of the Agenda: Approved without change.
- 3. Approval of Minutes of the December 7, 1999 Meeting: The minutes were approved as written.
- 4. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Treasurer Frances Finta reported that 65 of the 73 member organizations have paid their 1999/2000 dues.
