## Minutes - February 4, 2003

- 1. The President called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. There was one "community forum" presentation during the pre-meeting session. Ms. Palma Strand and Ms. Patrician discussed their survey, under contract to Arlington County, that looks at the community's about civic participation.
- 2. <u>Pledge of Allegiance</u>. The formal meeting began with recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Moment of Silence. Members observed a moment of silence in memory of the Columbia astraunauts.
- 4. <u>Approval of Agenda</u>. The agenda was approved as presented.
- 5. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>: Minutes from the December 3, 2002 meeting were approved.
- <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Treasurer Frances Finta's written report shows a combined checking and savings accounts balance of \$5,993.04, less a 911 Scholarship Fund balance of \$936.92, leaving a Federation balance of \$5,056.12. The report was accepted.
- <u>Committee Reports</u>: Brief committee reports were presented by the chairs of the following committees: Revenues & Expenditures, Public Services, Banquet, Membership, Planning & Zoning, Environmental, and Airport Issues.
- 8. Program. The program consisted of: 1) presentation on historic preservation; 2) proposed Chesapeake Bay Ordinance; and, 3) alternative fuels resolution. The presentation on historic preservation included a 30-minute presentation by Michael Leventhal, historic preservation coordinator of Arlington County, followed by 15 minutes of Q&A. The discussion of the Chesapeake Bay Ordinance included a 30-minute presentation by Jeff Harne, environmental coordinator for Arlington County, followed by 15 minutes of Q&A, which was followed by unanimous approval of a resolution regarding Arlington County's Chesapeake Bay Preservation Ordinance. Finally, there was discussion of a proposed resolution regarding alternative fuel buses and fueling facilities. The resolution passed with only one or two nay votes.

- <u>Announcements</u>. The debate for the March 11, 2003 special election is scheduled for Thursday, February 13, 2003. Arlingtonians for a Clean Environment is celebrating its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year. Finally, Neighborhood Day is scheduled for May 11.
