

Minutes - April 1, 2008 ACCF Membership Meeting

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Larry Mayer, President. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Burt Bostwick, of the Old Glebe Civic Association and Chair, Revenues and Expenditures.
- 2. Agenda approved as submitted.
- 3. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. The minutes of the March 4, 2008 membership meeting were distributed and approved as submitted.
- 4. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: The full report is available on Civic Federation website. Balance on hand is \$6,697.36.
- 5. Committee Reports and Announcements:
 - Transportation: Neighborhood Traffic Calming Manual review due April 5.

- 7. Budget Package Report Issues in the County budget proposal for 2009 were presented by Schools Committee Chair, Beth Wolffe, and Revenues and Expenditures Chair, Burt Bostwick. In further action:
 - Special Rules approved 26 yes to 8 no.
 - Revenues and Expenditures Committee proposal to endorse repeal of the Residential Utility Tax was carried 23 yes to 21 no.
 - Revenues and Expenditures Committee proposal for a reduction in the Homeowner Grant Program was defeated 19 yes to 22 no.
 - The total FY 2009 budget package was accepted 39 yes to 5 no.
- 8. There was no New Business. Delegates were urged to volunteer to participate in the Neighborhood Day parade (see details above).
