

## Minutes - February 3, 2009 ACCF Membership Meeting

- 1. Meeting called to order at 7:30 pm by Larry Mayer, President. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Patrick Hope of the Buckingham Civic Association
- 2. Agenda approved as submitted.
- 3. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. The minutes of the January 6, 2009 membership meeting were distributed and approved as submitted.
- 4. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Balance on February 3, 2009 is \$4,270.13. Fifty-three (64%) of member organizations have paid dues.
- 5. Committee Reports and Announcements:
  - Larry Finch: Two species of trees are available for the County's 2009 Tree Giveaway: a Bur Oak and an American Hazel.   - The Housing Committee (Kathryn Scruggs, chair) announces 4 principles to guide housing considerations for the 2010 County budget:
    - 1. Program policies should favor use of Affordable Housing Investment Funds (AHIF) to preserve affordable housing;
    - 2. Critical recreation areas should be preserved when public lands are considered for development.
    - 3. Increased funding may be needed for: Housing Grants, Transitional Housing Grants for homeless families with children, Permanent Supportive Housing, Homeless Shelter Programs.
    - 4. Establish a contingency fund to stimulate a public-private Homeless Trust Fund.
