

Minutes - June 2, 2009 ACCF Membership Meeting

- 1. The meeting called to order at 7:30 pm by Larry Mayer, President.
- 2. Agenda approved as submitted.
- 3. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>. The minutes of the May 5, 2009 membership meeting were distributed and approved as submitted.
- 4. Treasurer's Report: Dues year begins July 1.

Long-time civic activist, winner of the 2009 Sun Gazette Cup (see www.civfed.org/award09sunlowry.pdf) Roye Lowry presented "Arlington Retrospective/Prospective" as his last address to the members of the Civic Federation. Roye Lowry is featured in the documentary recently produced by the County: "Arlington's Smart Growth Journey?" -- it's 52 minutes and you'll find Roye at approximately 14:45, 29:25 and 41:00. At the conclusion of the presentation, a motion by Mileva Hartman, Membership Chair, that Roye Lowry be named honorary delegate in perpetuity was unanimously approved.
- 7. The Nominating Committee presented the election slate for 2009-2010 which was accepted by acclamation. Officers will be Mike Kerley, President; Mark Antell, Vice President; Sharon Rogers, Secretary; Eileen Williams, Treasurer. - 9. Jim Pebley presented the County's plans for a new Emergency Preparedness Advisory Commission (www.civfed.org/presepac0906.pdf) and its charger (www.civfed.org/epac_charger090519.pdf).

A joint resolution from the Schools and Revenue and Expenditures committees calling for a reexamination of the County's existing revenue-sharing agreement between the County and Arlington Public Schools was defeated by a vote of 16 in favor, 17 against.
