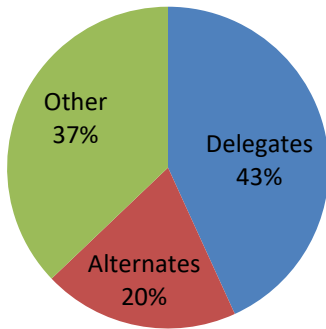

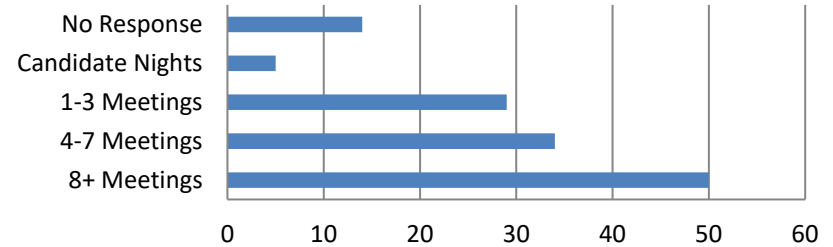
# Individual Participant Analytics



## Respondent Roles

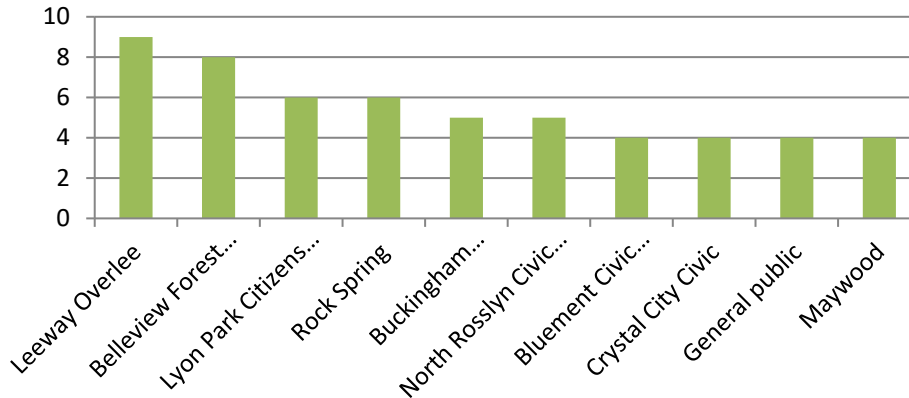


## Respondent Meeting Attendance

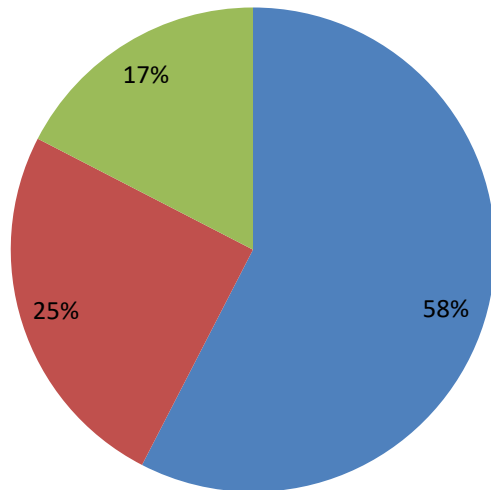
## Organizations with Most Individual Responses

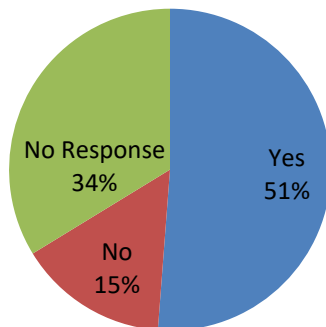
