Dear Chair de Ferranti and Members of the Arlington County Board:

I'm writing to inform you that the Arlington County Civic Federation (ACCF) has reviewed and approved a request from the Cherrydale Citizens Association (CCA) for a change in their association boundaries to include the area identified as the Cherry Valley Nature Area Neighborhood Association (CVNANA). The change in the boundaries was approved unanimously at ACCF's May 12, 2026 General Membership Meeting.

I am also copying the County Manager with the request that this change be conveyed to the appropriate offices to have the Arlington County maps and associated County engagements updated to reflect this change.

Approved Boundaries and Map

CVNANA is totally within the boundaries of CCA bounded on three sides by CCA to the north (18th St), on the west (Pollard Street Quincy Street), on the east (N Nelson St), and to the south by I66 (17th St and Custis Memorial Pkwy I66). This area is now included in CCA.



Background of Boundary Review Process

Since its founding in 2016, as the organization that has historically included all or most civic associations as members, ACCF has served as the manager for boundary changes for its members. Under the process, civic associations submit requests to ACCF for new or changed boundaries or boundary clarifications and ACCF conducts an extensive review and approval process following adopted and posted procedures, “CCF Procedures: Arlington Civic Association Boundaries – Establishment and Adjustments; BR2026-011, adopted 25 Jan 2026.” These recently updated procedures are available at [\[PDF, 196 KiB\]](#). Procedures are designed to provide full transparency, notification and inclusion for all impacted residents and to provide adjudication among civic associations as needed. Following review, recommendations for change are presented and approved by the full ACCF membership of organizations. Following ACCF approval, ACCF sends a notice to the Arlington County Board and the Clerk and the County Manager to transmit the changes to the appropriate communication and mapping offices to implement the change in the maps and the County offices.
