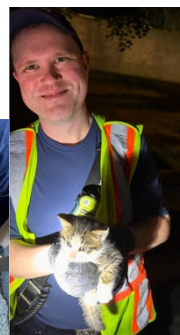
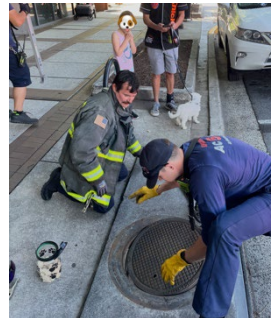














Arlington Professional Firefighters Benevolent Fund

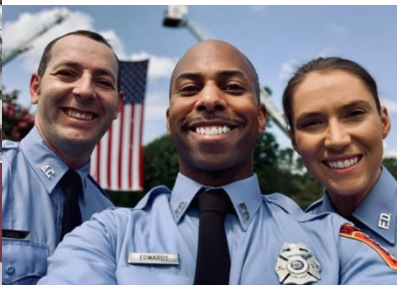

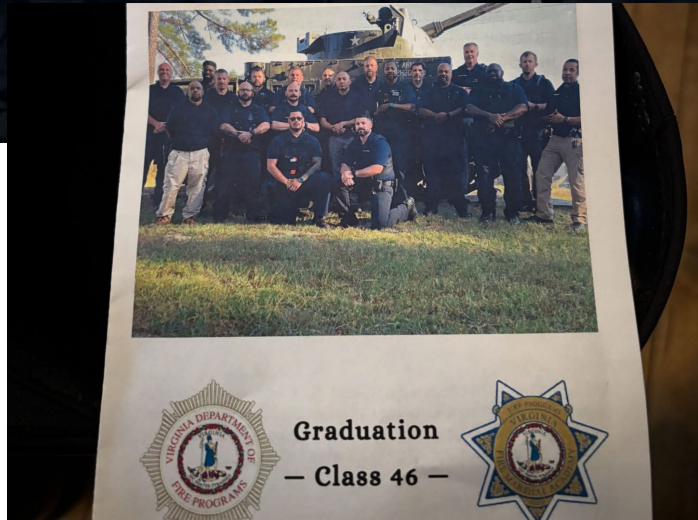

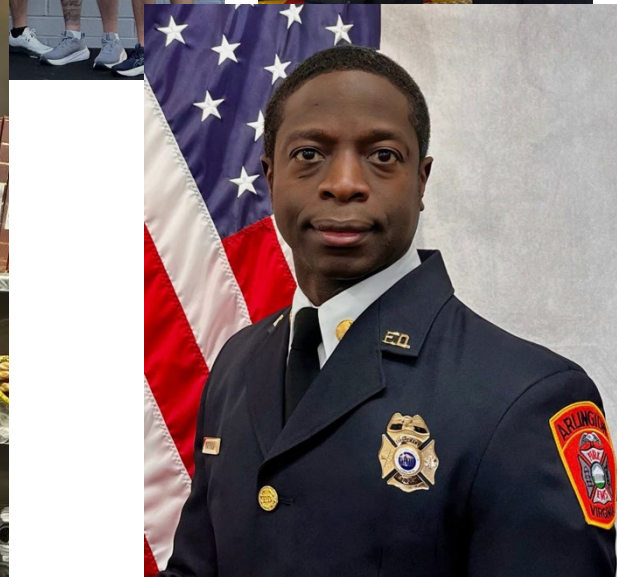
