Program Structure – The Agenda shows, we will first hear from each Delegate on their areas of concern, focus and, accomplishments. Specific Issues - The Legislative and Executive Committees discussed focusing on specific issues that are of interest to all Delegates and Alternates. "During debate, no delegate or alternate delegate shall speak more than twice on the same subject, or more than once, until all others have had the opportunity to speak. No delegate or alternate delegate shall speak more than two (2) minutes consecutively"

The Delegate panel's responses will not time limited for each question. Each panel participant might have information they desire to convey in response.
