The Business of Arlington

This month's program will focus on the elements of economic growth for Arlington County. Mr. Terry Holzheimer, who heads Arlington's Office Of Economic Development, will discuss the challenges and opportunities for Arlington in taking advantage of its location next to the Nation's Capital. This includes the construction and development sectors, transportation, retail, tourism, government contracting and finance. Also to be discussed will be the impact of BRAC, and the potential effect of the new Metro Silver Line. Arlington's strong commercial sector has allowed it to keep taxes relatively modest, while meeting the public safety, educational and social needs of Arlington's residents.

Mr. Holzheimer will be joined on the program by Mr. Rich Doud, President of the Arlington Chamber of Commerce. We believe this is the first occasion that the Civic Federation has hosted our business counterpart. The Chamber's goals for the year were recently published in the Sun
