

Population in Arlington and Virginia (2000-2010)

- 2000
 - Arlington County - 189,453 persons^[1]
 - Virginia - 7,078,515 persons^[2]
 - Arlington County represented 2.7% of the total Virginia population
- 2010
 - Arlington County – 211,400 population forecast^[3]
 - Arlington County is projected to grow by 11.6% from 2000 to 2010
 - Virginia - 8,010,245 population forecast^[4]
 - Virginia is projected to grow by 13.2% from 2000 to 2010
 - Arlington County is forecast to represent 2.6% of the total Virginia population

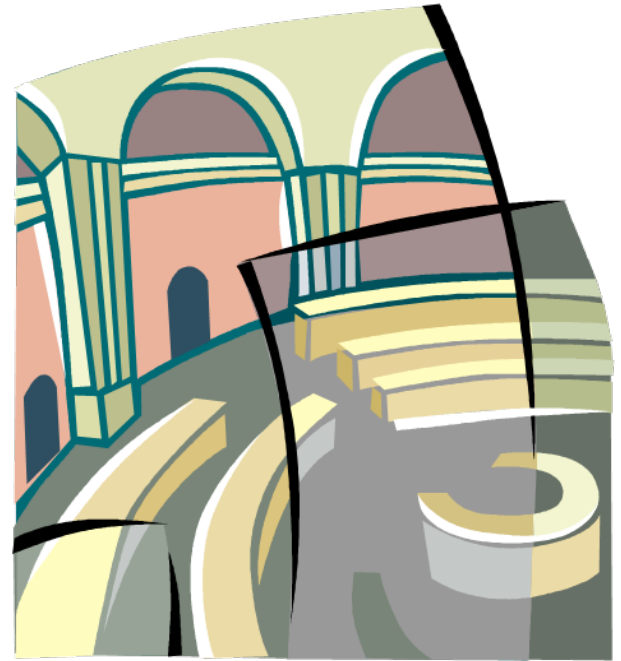

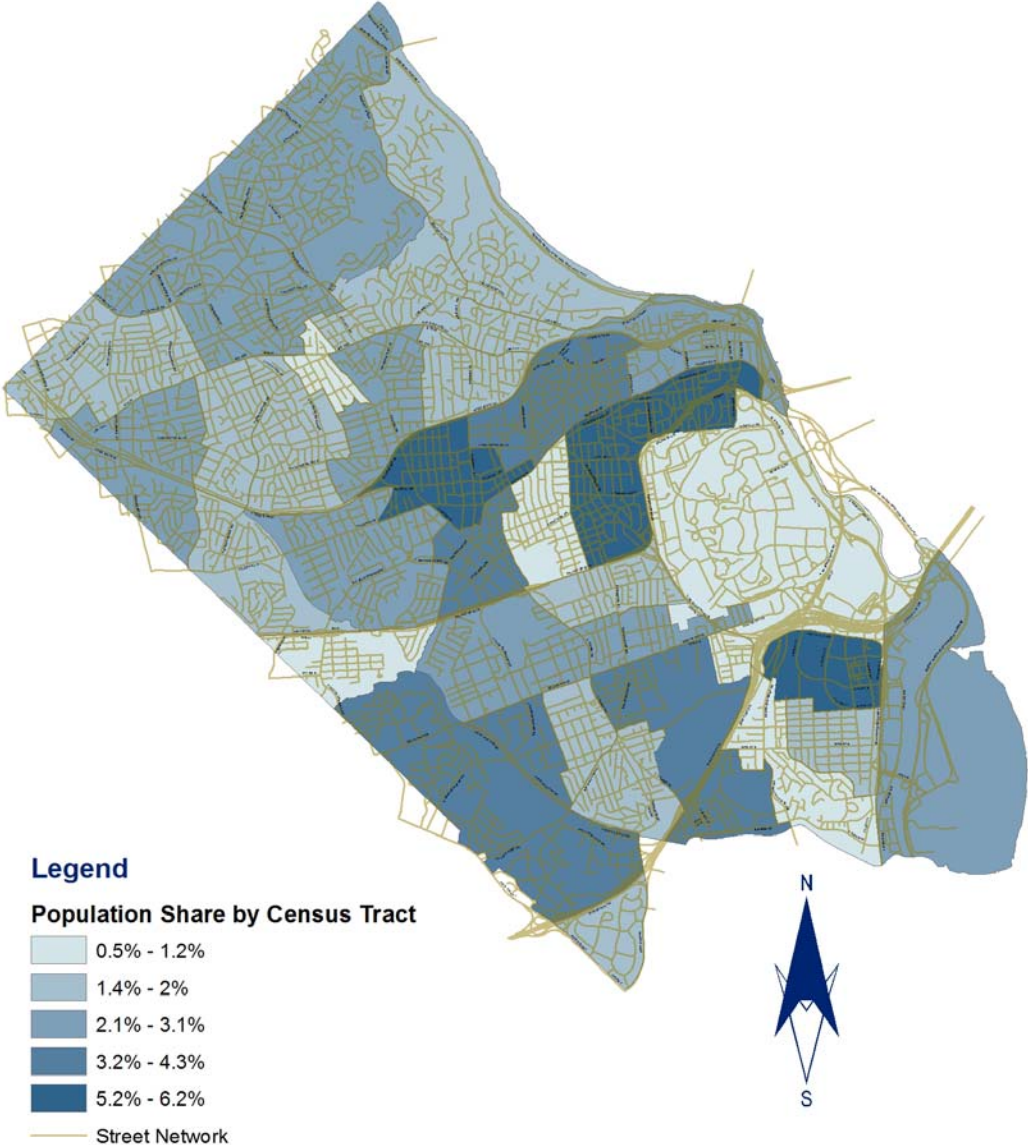

Arlington's Share in 2010

- Virginia House of Delegates
 - In 2010, each Virginia Delegate might represent about 80,102 persons
 - $8,010,245 / 100 = 80,102$
 - For Arlington County, this could represent 2.6 Virginia Delegates in 2010
 - $211,400 / 80,102 = 2.6$
- Virginia Senate
 - In 2010, each Virginia Senator might represent about 200,256 persons
 - $8,010,245 / 40 = 200,256$
 - For Arlington County, this could represent 1.1 Virginia Senators in 2010
 - $211,400 / 200,256 = 1.1$
