The Task From County Board Member Hynes ~~

- How can the County Board get more information from the community?
- Formed small group to study problem
- Quickly become apparent that
 - ☐ An umbrella organization was needed
 - ☐ Would report directly to the County Board
 - ☐ Unify and advocate community preparedness and emergency response
- EPAC was the logical outcome

County Board Charge - May 15, 2009

- Copies of the EPAC Charter are on line at CivFed.org
- Target date for implementation September 09
- Calls for Twelve Commissioners
 - ☐ Including one nominated by Civic Federation
- Local Federal and State groups invited to designate liaisons
- Satisfies the SARA Title III criteria

EPAC Functions and Scope

- ❖ Recommend measures to integrate community groups, businesses and individual citizen activities with government emergency planning activities
- ❖ Review and advise the County Board on County emergency preparedness planning
- ❖ Coordinate the functions of a Local Emergency Planning Committee in compliance with SARA Title III, the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986
- ❖ Participate with Site Plan Review Committees and Long Range Planning Committee
 - ✓ Provide policy recommendations as appropriate to guide emergency preparedness and safety issues in long range plans and site plans
- Review and advise the County Board on budget planning related to emergency preparedness and response
- Provide a periodic forum for community input to local emergency planning, mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery activities
