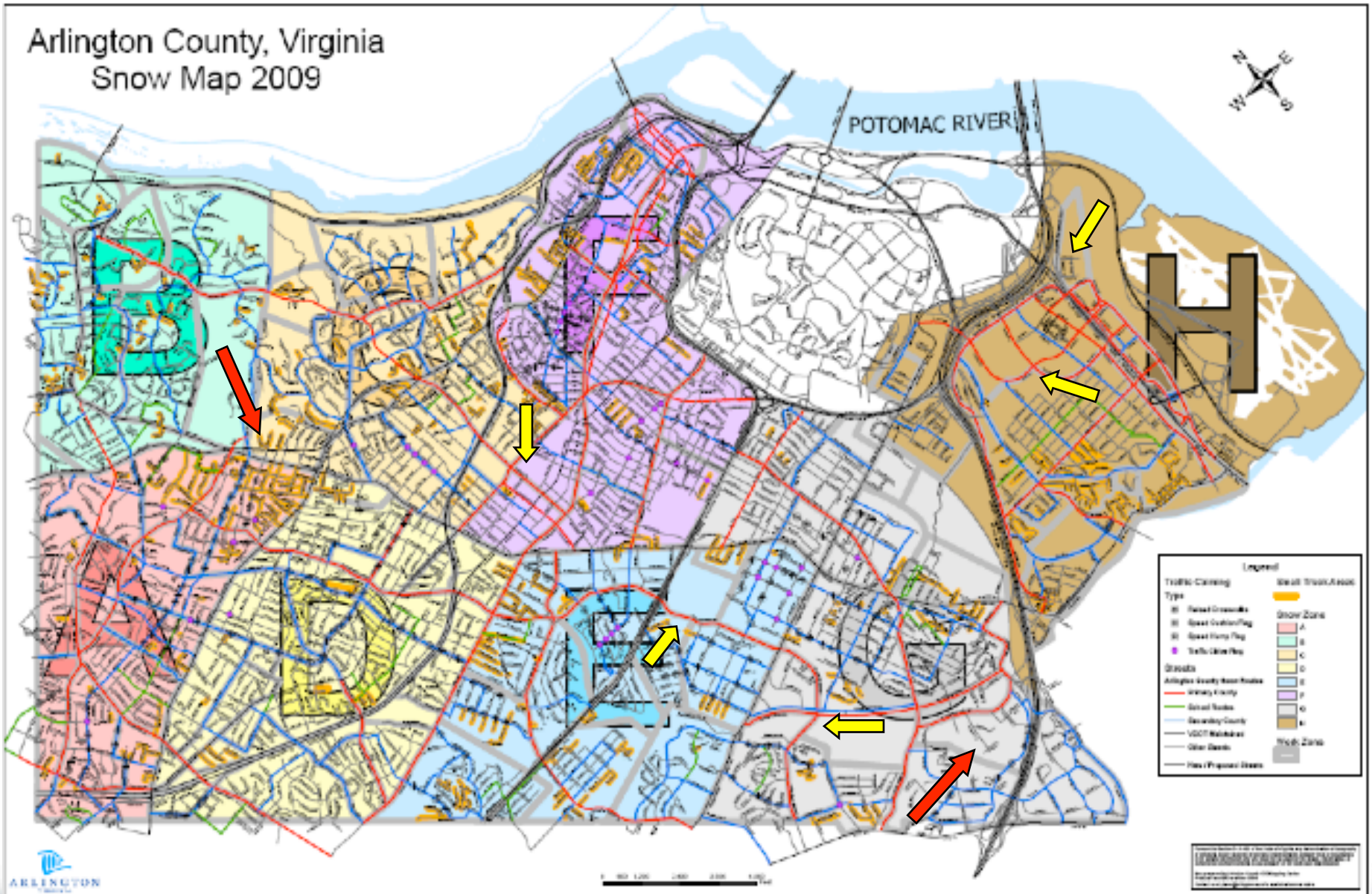


Snow Sections

Equipment

- Tandem Dump Trucks – 13
- Medium Dump Trucks – 20
- Pickup Trucks (1 Ton) – 8
- Small Dump Trucks (1 ¼ Ton) – 5 (4 with V-Box only)



- 45-50 snow removal vehicles (plows and salt spreaders)
- 100-110 drivers/operators
- 40+/- Support (Chain Shop, Admin, Snow Captains, Equipment Shop, Section Leaders)
- 10+ Water Distribution Staff to clear sidewalks and overpasses
- Equipment Bureau, PRCR, Solid Waste, WPCP, Traffic, etc.

Snow Melter and Haul Sites

- Snow Melter handles 60 Tons/hr
- Positioned at Haul Sites
- Activated with 6-8" predicted
- Contractors haul from Metro Corridors



- 703-228-6485 is for Snow Information
- Recorded message with status of response and whether we're taking requests
- No requests dispatched until substantially complete (resource efficiency)
- ECC (Police/Fire) calls are dispatched immediately (Citizens call 911 for Emergencies)
- **E-Form** reporting via www.Arlingtonva.us. We will now be expecting most requests to come to us through our **E-Form**.

New Initiatives for 2010-2011 Winter

- RASTRAC Automated Vehicle Location system installed on trucks.
- E-Form Implemented on www.Arlingtonva.us to supplant snow@arlingtonva.us e-mail and other inefficient methods
- Salt Brine making machine and 4 tanks/spreaders for deploying salt brine for pre-treatment purposes
 - Red and Blue Routes primarily, including bridges
- 4 Contract Tandem Dumps for Columbia Pike/Sections G&H
